

Steps to Gaining Off-Campus Access to the Electronic Databases

1 In your Internet Browser, go to the Wilmington University homepage.

<http://www.wilmu.edu>

2 Click on the [WebCampus](#) link on the top of the webpage. Log into the WebCampus portal.

3 On the left menu of WebCampus under 'Research,' choose 'Library Databases.' Then click, 'Access Library Databases'. This will automatically direct you into the Wilmington University proxy server. From here you are able to access any of our Library Research Databases.
