

Material Access

- ◆ **Be sure to first check out all of the WU Library online resources first!**
- ◆ **Library Card**– WU students attending classes in NJ may obtain a local Library card for NJ Library resources.
 - **Cumberland County College:** To obtain a Student ID, students must visit the Fitness Center in the Gym and present valid documentation that indicates they are enrolled in WU for the current semester. Library cards can be obtained at the Library's circulation desk. An ID card must be presented to receive a Library card.
 - **Salem Community College:** Students may apply for a Library card by visiting the Library, located on the first floor of the Donahay Building directly across from Student Services. A student ID or driver's license is required to receive a card. Remote access to the research databases is available by first visiting the circulation desk.
 - **Burlington (Pemberton & Mount Laurel Campuses):** WU students and faculty apply for ID at Public Safety. The library barcode will be affixed to the back of the ID at the Circulation Desk, at either the Mount Laurel or Pemberton campus libraries. This provides access to all library privileges, including off campus database access.
- ◆ **Material Delivery**– Enrolled students and WU Faculty at New Jersey sites can have materials mailed to their home by calling the 800 Line. Be sure to have your WU ID number ready.
- ◆ **Interlibrary Loan**- Materials not owned by the University or unavailable electronically can be obtained through ILL. Requests can be made online or by calling the 800 Line.

Online Resources

While attending classes in New Jersey, Wilmington University Students have full access to our Electronic Research Databases. Students may also search our library-owned materials off-campus using the Library Online Catalog, WebCat.

Electronic Research Databases

To find research articles, use our Electronic Databases. Our databases cover many subject areas. To view a full list of databases please visit the Library website. Gain off-campus access to the Library Electronic Research Databases by following these simple steps:

- 1** In your Internet Browser, go to the Wilmington University homepage.

- 2** Click on the [WebCampus](#) link on the top of the webpage. Login to WebCampus using your username and password provided at the top of your course enrollment form.
- 3** On the left menu of WebCampus under the Research category choose 'Library Databases.' Then click, 'Access Library Databases'. This will automatically direct you into the Wilmington University proxy server. From here you are able to access any of our Library Research Databases.

Library Online Catalog- WebCat

Anyone can access our Catalog of Library-Owned Materials. Simply visit the Library homepage @ www.wilmu.edu/library

From here click on [Online Catalog \(WebCat\)](#), located underneath the Research category.

Here you will find materials owned by the Library such as books, Videos, DVDs', etc.

You can also use WebCat to renew your items, place holds and view materials on reserve.

While in New Jersey, keep in mind we provide a material delivery service to all students and faculty. Students enrolled at sites other than in New Castle can have materials mailed to their home by calling the Library toll free at 1-800-451-5724.

Public Library Online Resources– New Jersey

JerseyClicks is New Jersey's statewide portal that features federated searching of the statewide full-text databases offered by the New Jersey State Library, the New Jersey Network, and funds from the Library Services and Technology Act.

The portal can be found at www.jerseyclicks.org

To access the research databases simply type in your search terms in the QuickSearch box. You will be prompted to enter your library card number at this time. Anyone with a library card from a New Jersey Public Library may use JerseyClicks.

If you do not have a library card, visit your local public library to obtain one.
