Choose whether or not you would like to include your webcam in your presentation and ensure the correct video and audio devices are selected. Ideally you'll use a USB headset, but a webcam the built-in microphone on your computer will work.



Import your PowerPoint using the "Browse" button and you will be given a preview of your first slide.

When you are ready, click record.

You can click through your slides using the right and left arrow keys. When you're finished, press the "Done" button. You'll have the opportunity to preview your recording again, cut out any extra time, and give it a new name before you upload it. When it's finished uploading it will appear in your My Media list in Blackboard.
