

Job Placement Rate (percentage)

We are currently in the process of accumulating data in regards to job placement and employer satisfaction. Information will be updated once data has been compiled.

Number of Program Graduates from the Past Year

In 2014 the Clinical Mental Health Counseling program graduated their first students under the new 60 credit requirement - 19 students graduated.

The program also had 5 students who graduated with their Community Counseling degree. They were the last remaining students under that degree program.

Completion Rate (percentage)

In 2011 the CMHC program accepted 45 students and 39 enrolled. In 2014, 19 students graduated (representing a 48.72% graduate rate) and 5 more are predicted to graduate in 2015 (representing a potential 61.54% graduation rate).

Certification Pass Rate (percentage)

The 2014 National Counselor Exam (NCE) pass rate was at a program high of 92.31%.

Applicants Accepted (percentage)

In 2010 the MSCC program had 108 applicants from which 34 were accepted – a 31% acceptance rate. In 2011, the CMHC program had 114 applicants from which 45 were accepted – a 39% acceptance rate. In 2012, there were 119 applicants from which 36 were accepted – a 30% acceptance rate. In 2013, there were 111 applicants from which 40 were accepted – a 36% acceptance rate. In 2014, there were 75 applicants from which 45 were accepted – a 60% acceptance rate.

* The acceptance rates vacillate from year to year due to various situations and conditions.

Number of Enrolled Students

We currently have 101 students in our program.
