

In addition to the traditional DNP pathway (with a choice of Advanced Practice or Leadership), WilmU also offers: an accelerated MSN to DNP pathway, a combined DNP + MBA in Health Care Administration, a DNP + MS in Management in Health Care Administration, a PhD to DNP pathway and a combined DNP + Post-Master's Nurse Practitioner certificate in five specialties.

Note: For the dual-degree options of DNP + MBA or MS in Management, candidates must first be accepted into the DNP program and then work with the college to add the MBA or MS in Management. In order to qualify for the dual degree, the programs must be started at the same time. Contact your program chair for quidance.

Advanced Practice Registered Nurses are required to complete 33 credits and 500 practice experience hours. Advanced Practice Registered Nurses will take 12 courses, which can be completed in 28 months.

**Nurse Leaders** are required to complete 45 credits and 1,000 practice experience hours. Nurse Leaders will take 16 courses, which can be completed in 28 months.
