# Case Management for Human Services

## **Graduate Certificate**

This certificate offers a graduate–level study option for students seeking in–depth knowledge of working in human services and providing direct client care. Case management is a practitioner skills subset within the larger, interdisciplinary, human and community services field. This Case Management for Human Services Certificate emphasizes preparing practitioners to work with individuals and/or groups needing help in accessing services and resources that facilitate well–being among those in need. The program provides career–oriented courses that will prepare students to work in a variety of settings, including social services, community agencies, educational institutions, business organizations and government agencies.

# Option to Apply Certificate Credits Toward a Master of Science Degree in Human Services

Graduate students enrolled in the Case Management in Human Services Certificate have the option to apply certificate credits toward a Human Services Master of Science degree. Certificate course requirements fulfill four of the five elective requirements and one core course requirement for the Human Services Master of Science Degree.


