Graduate Certificate

The **Teaching in Higher Education Certificate** is designed for those interested in learning how to teach at the college level within their disciplines. Candidates will learn about best practices in teaching adults, gain knowledge about developing curriculum and assessing student learning, and gain hands-on experience. Students will participate in 120 hours of field-based work to gain experience in a higher education setting and develop a portfolio to highlight their work.
