This program builds upon a 15-credit foundation of core courses, including Global Leadership, 21st Century Globalization, Culture & Communications, and Research Writing. A three-credit Demonstration of Mastery project rounds out the foundation. The program also features an optional concentration in Social and Emotional Intelligence.

Credit Transfer From Any Field: Up to 12 previously earned graduate-level credits from any field of study can be transferred and applied to this degree.
