## **Show College Readiness**

Submit your official SAT scores or take Delaware Tech's placement test (ACCUPLACER). For placement testing information, please contact your campus Admissions Office.

Policy for placement in college-level courses:

demonstrate college readiness.

- Students with a 3.0 (83%) or higher cumulative high school GPA can be placed into college-level courses (transcript required).
- Students using high school GPA for placement will still be required to submit SAT or ACCUPLACER scores.

• Submit college transcript (official college transcript required for transfer credit).

Provide Proof of Delaware Residency (if applicable/required for in-state tuition):
