





Scholarships

Many organizations provide scholarships to students. WilmU also awards a number of scholarships each year to our students based on various criteria.

Employer Reimbursement

Many businesses help their employees pay for school. Contact your employer's human resources department to see if tuition benefits are available.

Military Benefits

Individuals who have served or are currently serving in the military—as well as their dependents—may be eligible to have their tuition covered under veterans' benefits.

Federal Student Aid

Federal Student Aid is the most common form of financing for students. To be considered for federal aid, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).


